RE: GM's Announcement Regarding Their Jack Cooper Contract

Dear Jack Cooper Members:

Your Local Union leadership was alerted of General Motors' unexpected announcement regarding Jack Cooper Transport, and the potential impact this decision could have on you and your jobs, late Thursday evening.

Upon hearing the news, Local 243 immediately contacted both the International Union, and the IBT Carhaul Division, seeking clarification and further details.

As of today, we have not yet heard back from the IBT. However, as the conversation over the Jack Cooper/General Motors relationship goes on, we expect to hear further information about this decision, and its short-term and long-term impact, shortly. Once we do, we will pass the information along in real time.
