For Local 243 UPS Members


As you are aware from previous bulletins Teamsters Local 243 Metro-Detroit Rider negotiations have been ongoing. At the direction of the Stewards, Committeepersons and the Membership, Local 243 has attempted to obtain language on Article 22.4 combination drivers; extension of the Local 243 Rider to Lansing, Jackson and Adrian; pay for time spent retaining airport badges; and various other open issues.


The parties have met and bargained a total of 16 sessions, most recently on December 6th and 7th; however, we are no closer to an agreement today than we were prior to the Rider being rejected. Several key issues as listed above continue to remain unresolved. Additional important information will be forthcoming as it becomes available.
