

“PHASE 3” of Local 243’s UPS 9.5 Battle Settled For Additional \$18,325.08

“Phase 3” of Local 243’s 9.5 grievance battle against UPS has been completed, resulting in an additional **\$18,325.08** in payments to RPCDs who filed grievances over the Company’s violation of their 9.5 contractual protections.

These 9.5 grievances, combined with the 9.5 grievances already paid to members in Phases 1 and 2 brings the total 9.5 payments to Local 243 UPS members to **\$88,814.76**

Local 243 Vice President Scott Quenneville said that as the Union begins to wrap up its 500-plus 9.5 grievance battle against UPS, he thanked all members for their patience throughout this process in standing with the Union as we fight to protect members’ 9.5 contractual rights.

“We understand that this has been a long 9.5 battle, but the final outcome proves that when members unite and use grievance and arbitration procedure to fight for their rights, we have the power to secure justice,” Quenneville said. “The 9.5 protection is a crucial element of our UPS contract and Local 243 is determined to do everything we can to protect our members’ rights.
